Monks, sexual misconduct, when practised, developed and repeatedly performed, causes one to arise in hell, in the world of animals and in the world of ghosts; the very least result of practising sexual misconduct is that one will breed rivalry and hatred when reborn as a man.

Monks, telling lies, when practised, developed and repeatedly performed, causes one to arise in heli, in the world of animals and in the world of ghosts; the very least result of telling lies is that one will be falsely accused when reborn as a man.

Monks, backbiting, when practised, developed and repeatedly performed, causes one to arise in hell, in the animal world and in the world of ghosts: the very least result of backbiting is the breaking up of one's friendships when reborn as a man.

Monks, harsh speech when practised, developed and repeatedly performed, causes one to arise in hell, in the animal world and in the world of ghosts; the very least result of harsh speech is that one will possess an unpleasing voice when reborn as a man.

Monks, frivolous talk, when practised, developed and repeatedly performed, causes one to arise in hell, in the world of animals and in the world of ghosts; the very least result of frivolous talks is that one's words will not be accepted when reborn as a man.

Monks, partaking of intoxicants, when practised, developed and repeatedly performed, causes one to arise in hell, in the world of animals and in the world of ghosts; the very least result of partaking of intoxicants is that one will be afflicted with insanity when reborn as a man.
